## Desk Hutches

---

### Q1. What hutch width should I buy?

**A:** Match the hutch width exactly to your desk width. If your desk is 60", buy a 60" hutch. Hutches that are narrower than the desk look incomplete; wider hutches create mounting and visual problems.

---

### Q2. How do I check if a hutch will fit my ceiling?

**A:** Add your desk height (usually 29"–30") to the hutch height (usually 36"–42"). This gives you total installed height. You want at least 12" of clearance to the ceiling. Most 8' ceilings accommodate a standard desk + hutch easily.

---

### Q3. Does a hutch work on a sit-stand desk?

**A:** No. A fixed hutch can't travel with a sit-stand desk as it raises. Use wall-mounted overhead shelving or nearby freestanding shelving instead.

---

### Q4. What goes on a desk hutch?

**A:** Books, binders, reference materials, decorative items, diplomas, framed photos, and small organizational accessories. Avoid heavy items near the edges of shelves, and stay within the hutch's weight rating (typically 50–100 lbs total).

---

### Q5. What if my desk line is discontinued and I can't find a matching hutch?

**A:** Contact us — we often know of compatible hutch options from other lines that work with discontinued desks. In some cases, a coordinating hutch in a similar finish family can work if an exact match isn't available.
